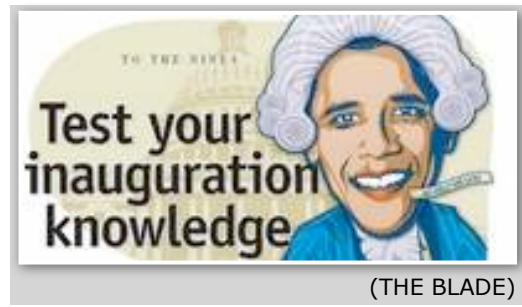


## TEST YOUR INAUGURATION KNOWLEDGE
